Caravan folding roofs: Sympatex interior tent for excellent thermal insulation

Sympatex Technologies supplies two products which are used for the interior lining of folding caravan roofs (for example for the VW T5) in the form of its caravan roof lining laminates. The basis for these two products is the 100% wind- and waterproof and optimally breathable 'guaranteed green' Sympatex membrane. This is made into a user-specific laminate with a textile backing material to provide campers with great conditions all year round.

A 2-layer and a 3-layer velour laminate is made into an interior tent for this purpose. This material combination provides excellent thermal insulation in all weathers.

- When it is windy or draughty outside, the 100% windproof membrane has a protective, insulating effect.
- In cold weather, the air heated by the heating system cannot escape to the outside.
- If the roof is closed in rain and the lining is wet, the optimally breathable and 100% waterproof Sympatex® laminates protect the mattress and the interior from dampness and moisture to create a pleasant interior climate.
- In high summer, it is much cooler under the roof since the double wall comprising the lining and interior fabric also provides protection from heat and sunshine. The use of a black membrane also prevents possible overheating due to sunshine.

Furthermore, the Sympatex® laminates reduce outside noise in the sleeping area and the blackout effect produced by the use of the black membrane creates perfect sleeping conditions. The grey velour used as the outer material has a pleasant look and a soft feel and therefore helps to ensure maximum comfort in the sleeping area. The laminates are also flame-retardant to comply with standard requirements for non-flammable materials inside motor vehicles.

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
